## **Bilingual Parents as Teachers Home Visitor Full Time Position in Northern Chautauqua County**

Using the Parents as Teachers (PAT) curriculum, a Home Visitor meets with families, focusing on parent-child interactions, development centered parenting and family well-being. In a culturally sensitive way, the Home Visitor partners, facilitates, and reflects with families to help them reach their goals and understand they are their child's first and best teacher.

### **Core Responsibilities:**

- Engage in recruitment of families with children prenatal- 5 years
- Maintains a set caseload of families
- Plan, provide and documents personal monthly home visits
- Provide group connections to give families an opportunity to build social connections
- Complete developmental screenings (ASQ3 and ASQSE2) with parents and make referrals as needed
- Connect families to resources that help them reach their goals and address their needs
- Help parents and children transition to other services as needed.
- Travel required with mileage reimbursement.

### **Qualifications:**

- Bachelors or Associates degree in early childhood education, social work, health, psychology or related is preferred, will consider 2 years supervised experience working with children and/or parents.
- Knowledge of child development and milestones for children birth- 5 years old
- Computer skills: Word, Excel, Google Docs, web-based database, and email
- Ability to work independently and be self-motivated
- Ability to establish rapport with families and empower them by building on strengths
- Strong organizational and record keeping skills
- Bilingual
